Exploration of Kanchinjunga.

An expedition will, it is stated, start from Darjeeling early in September next to explore the glaciers of Kanchinjunga. The members composing the party are Mr. A. Crowley, Dr. Jacob Guillarmod, and Messrs. Raymond and Packe, two Swiss amateur mountaineers. Dr. Guillarmod and Mr. Crowley are well-known climbers, and have had some Himalayan experience in Baltistan. The expedition will proceed via the Pamayanchi Jongri over the Kang La to Tseram, about 16,000 feet. The formal sanction of the Nepaul durbar is awaited. It is believed that the exploration is being made at the instance of a private syndicate, and it is hoped that it will beat the record in the way of height.
