The bodies of poor Pache and the three coolies were, I am glad to say, recovered. Had it not been for this sad accident, which was the sole reason which caused the expedition to return, the party were hopeful of accomplishing their task. The members of the expedition are stout-hearted fellows, and it is unfortunate their efforts were attended with bad luck. Mr. Crowley intends returning to Darjeeling next year with the object of renewing the attempt.
